Screening of the new documentary film, UNFRACTURED, by the award-winning feminist filmmaker, Chanda Chevannes. Premiering in Ithaca last spring as part of the Finger Lakes Environmental Film Festival, UNFRACTURED is a hopeful documentary about speaking data to power. The story follows introspective biologist--and Ithaca College scholar in residence--Sandra Steingraber as she uses science in the service of social change and reinvents herself along the way. Sandra quickly emerges as a leader of New York's biggest grassroots movement in decades as it fights for a statewide ban on fracking. This screening will be preceded by a short presentation by Dr. Steingraber about the role of feminism, science, and civil disobedience in the climate justice movement.
